

14 MONTPELIER STREET LONDON SW7

A building originally used as a nurses' home and located in the heart of Knightsbridge was ideal for the creation of large lateral apartments.

Hamiltons were appointed by the incoming purchaser who had the benefit of an existing approval. A thorough assessment of the approved drawings led us to consider alternatives and produce a design which maximised the development potential of the site and improve the quality of the apartments. Four large lateral apartments and two duplexes have their living space behind the West-facing facade, and bedrooms in the new block to the rear. the new building uses the geometry of adjacent buildings to mediate between old and new elements. a sophisticated roof form encloses a spectacular duplex penthouse.
